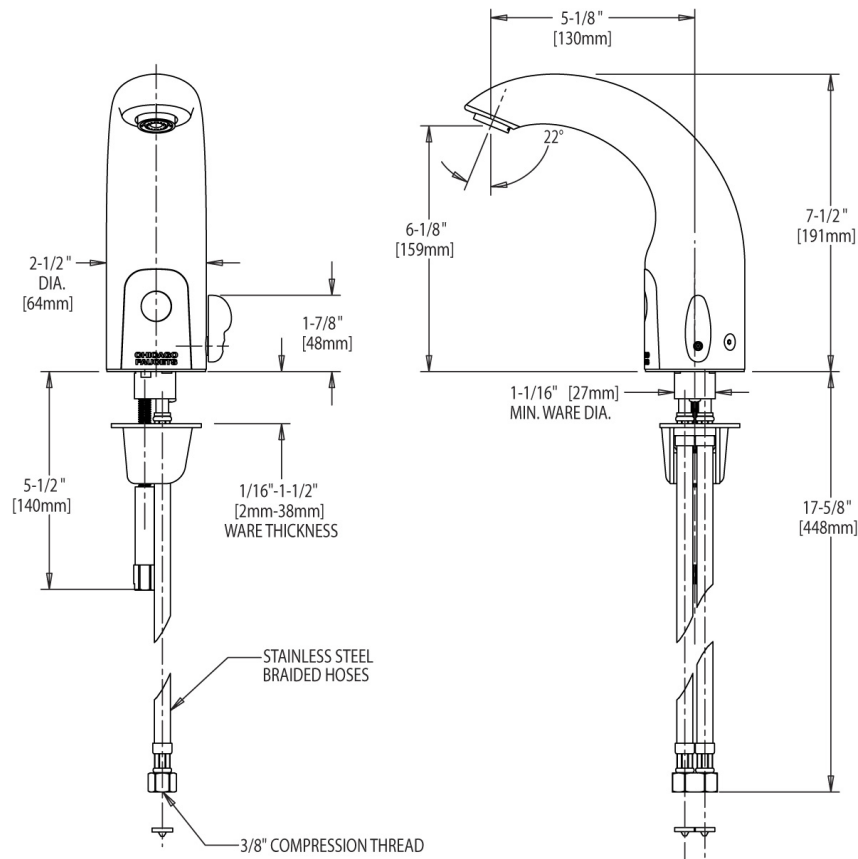

Single-hole deck mount. 0.5 GPM (1.9 L/min) vandal-proof, pressure compensating, Econo-Flo, non-aerating spray. Includes optional 2.2 GPM (8.3 L/min) aerator insert. Dual supply for hot and cold water service. 12-volt AC transformer required (order separately). Flexible supply hoses included. User-adjustable temperature control mixer. Operation and Maintenance
